ABOUT THE PROJECT

Campaigning against gender (in)equality is an Erasmus+ Youth Exchange which will be held in Fornos de Algodres, Portugal, from 27th of March (arrival day) till the 4th of April (departure day).

The project will gather **42 youngsters** (5 from each country + 1 group leader) from **Portugal, Spain, Netherlands, Italy, Slovenia, Romania and Greece.**

This project aims to address the issue of gender (in)equality by improving the capacity of young leaders and youth workers from different cultural backgrounds in order to develop more equal communities.

WORKING METHODS

All the project activities will be done through the methods of **non-formal education**.

The activities will be for example brainstorming together, plenary discussions, simulations, role plays, team building, energizers, ice breakers and many others. Non-formal education is voluntary, non hierarchical and all its methods are based on the concept of learning by doing.

PARTICIPANTS PROFILE

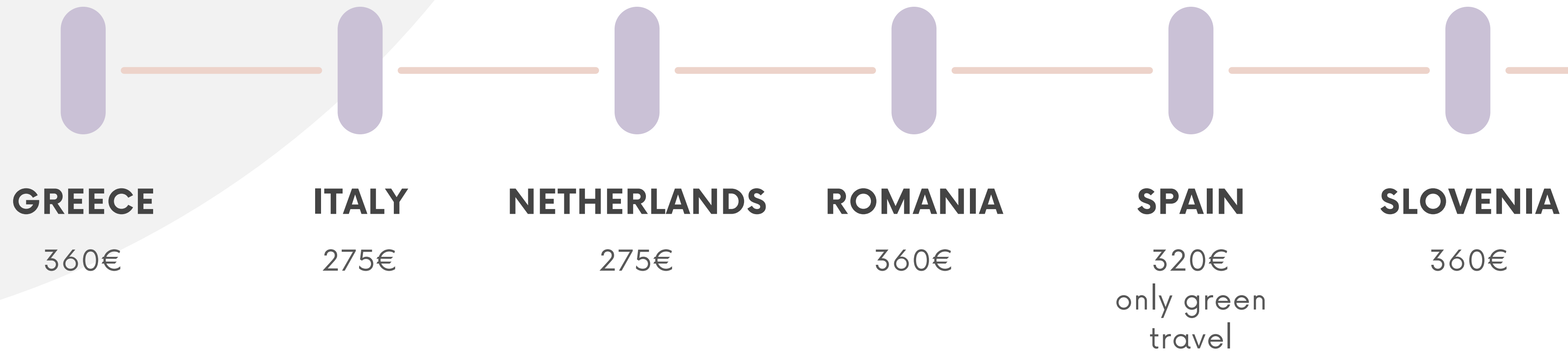
The participants involved in this project will be youth workers and leaders interested in intercultural learning, and according to the following profile:

- Attitude for dialogue and mutual understanding;
- Gender balance have to be followed as much as possible;
- Priority will be given to youth workers with fewer opportunities background

TRAVEL REIMBURSEMENT PROCEDURE

- Each participant will receive the 100% of the total reimbursement within the limits after the presentation of all the official original documents (Boarding Passes and Invoices), and after they have concluded the follow-up activities, dissemination of results;
- Be aware that the reimbursement will be calculated according to the travel costs of participants, from their place of origin to the venue of the activity and return;
- The reimbursement will be made by bank transfer to the bank account of the NGO partner in the project.

COVID19 tests and health insurance are not refundable.

ABOUT TICKETS

Do **NOT** buy any ticket without our confirmation or permission!

Before buying the tickets you should always address to us and send us travel plan of the participant and **ONLY** after our authorization you can proceed.

Also, tickets should be bought in **Economy Class** and private transportation is not reimbursed. Participants are invited to propose the most economic options.

The reimbursement will be made between **2 and 4 months** after the project is implemented and after all the dissemination tasks done by each participant and all tickets delivered to us.

VENUE & HOW TO REACH FORNOS DE ALGODRES

Venue and accommodation of the project will be in Fornos de Algodres, in the students' residence located in the city center. The residence will accommodate participants in rooms of 4, 6 and 8 participant per room.

To travel to PORTUGAL and reach the venue in Fornos de Algodres you need to travel to OPORTO Airport (~1h50 from Fornos de Algodres).

VENUE & HOW TO REACH FORNOS DE ALGODRES

All the group will be picked up from Oporto airport at around 18h00 on the 27th of March. On the last day, the group will be taken from Fornos de Algodres to Oporto airport at around 6h30am, meaning you will arrive at the airport a bit after 8am. For this reason, the flights you take shouldn't arrive after 18h00 on the 27th of March and shouldn't depart earlier than 11h00 on the 4th of April.

The project will have a participation fee of 40 euros. This will be used for the transportation of the group from Oporto Airport to Fornos de Algodres, and return to Oporto Airport on last day. This amount will not be taken if you have at least 40 Euros left in your travel budget.
